



Seal-Pup Guide

General use instructions for the Glacier Tanks Seal Pup

WHAT IS IT?

The Seal-Pup is a barrel transfer device. It has been developed to ensure a safe and sanitary transfer under pressure for any product, out of almost any size wooden barrel. The adjustable cane allows product transfer while leaving any sediment that may be in the barrel behind.



PRE-USE

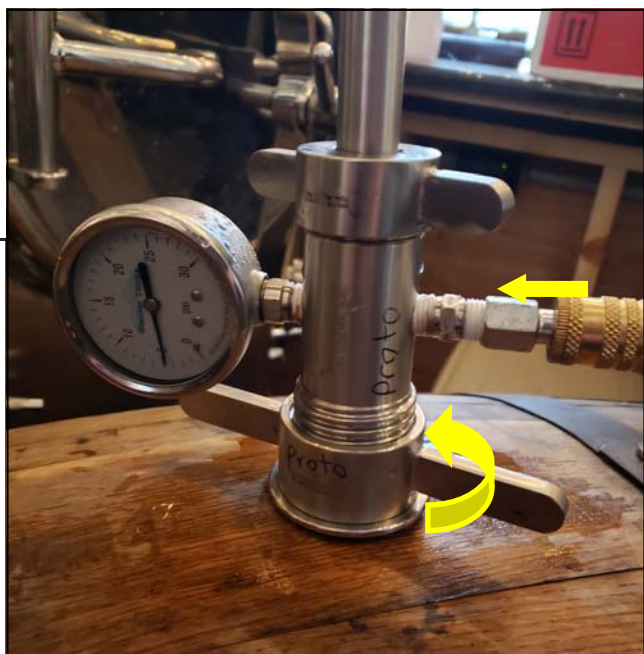
Before the Seal-Pup is used, it should be disassembled, cleaned, and sanitized. If soaking the Seal Pup with other fittings, take care not to damage the bung.

STEP 1

Once the correct size stopper is selected. The Seal-Pup is placed in the bung hole of the barrel (see left).

STEP 2

To achieve the proper seal; tighten the bung crank until the bung has made a tight seal in the bunghole. Attach your air line to the quick connect (See right).



STEP 3

Slowly add pressure until the product begins to flow (see left).

WARNING! Do not exceed 7 PSI. Doing so can cause personal injury or property damage.

Once the transfer is complete The Seal-Pup easily comes apart for cleaning and sanitizing. The sanitary design will prevent unwanted oxidation as well as contamination. The ease of function makes the Seal-Pup an invaluable piece of equipment for any cellar.
